Infant Baptism

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

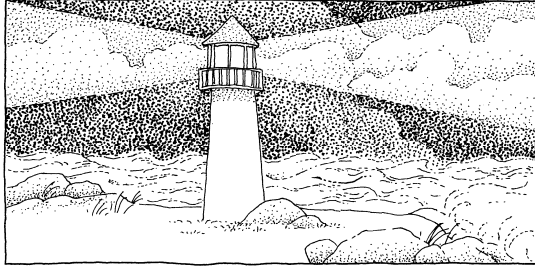

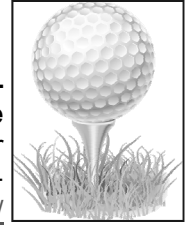

The Catholic Home Missions Appeal supports dioceses in the United States and its territories that lack the resources to provide basic pastoral ministry to their populations. Through annual grants, Catholic Home Missions funds catechesis, seminarian education, lay ministry training, Hispanic ministry, and evangelization. Catholic Home Missions also monitors the projects of [grant recipients](#) and builds lasting networks to increase awareness of the Church's need within the United States.

For example, Prince of Peace Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lexington is the only Catholic presence in two Kentucky counties. The pastor splits his time between Prince of Peace and St. Julie's, a parish 25 miles away. The difficult travel and economic hardships in Appalachia strain the resources of the diocese. Support from the Appeal provides well-trained lay ministers and deacons to attend to the spiritual needs of those in the region and also allows Prince of Peace Parish to provide a food and clothing bank for those in need. As a result of parishioners' generosity, Catholic Home Missions impacts the lives of over 160 million Catholics each year by providing support for essential pastoral ministries. Grants funded by the Appeal help to spread a Catholic presence in isolated communities. The [dioceses funded](#) by the Appeal comprise nearly 45% of the total number of U.S. dioceses.

Reminders for the Sacraments that will be celebrated this Spring are as follows:

First Holy Communion practice for the school and Religious Education students will be held on Wednesday, May 1st at 5:00pm in the church for only the parent and the child receiving. The actual Sacrament of First Holy Communion will be celebrated on Saturday, May 4th at 2pm Mass. Please have the children brought to the school classroom (2C) at 1:30pm to check in and line up.

The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated on Monday, May 20, 2013 at 5:00pm Mass for grades 8 to 12 in Religious Education, and our SFC School students, by the Most Reverend Bishop Thomas Daly. Practices and the distribution of the robes will be the week prior, and the robes are returned immediately after the Mass. For these Sacraments the Communicants, Confirmandi and Sponsors all need to be able to receive Eucharist in the State of Grace.
