SACRAMENTAL LIFE

Infant Baptism

Parents must be registered in the parish a minimum of 3 months prior to taking the baptismal preparation class. Contact the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Please contact the Parish Office if you are baptized in the Catholic Church and seeking confirmation as an adult, or are considering or desiring to become Catholic and are baptized in another Christian church or are not baptized and are 7 years of age or older.

Marriage

Couples must contact the Priest they wish to witness the Sacrament at least 6 months prior to the proposed date of marriage. Contact the Parish Office.

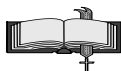

VOCATIONS

This Sunday is called World Day of Prayer for Vocations. We are called to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. You may have noticed that our parish's response to that request includes a petition for vocations at all weekend Masses. Let us continue to pray and encourage more people to respond to the wonderful gift of priesthood and religious life.

The Catholic Church uses the whole month of May to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary, our Mother. You will find a statue of the Blessed Mother next to the baptismal font for the whole month of May. Most of us have special memories of the May crowing of Mary, offering her flowers at church, or having a special procession for her. Some of us even have an altar for Mary at home. I encourage you to offer her some flowers during this month of May and to try to meditate upon the mysteries of her rosary. When the rosary is prayed privately, we have the opportunity to enter the mysteries of our salvation. When the rosary is prayed with a group, especially with the family, the entire Church family is blessed. You are indeed invited to pray the rosary daily following the 8:30 a.m. Mass on weekdays, and prior to the 8:30 a.m. Mass on the First Saturday of the month. True devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary always leads us to her Son, our Lord Jesus Christ.

Please join me in congratulating the 77 young people from our parish who received the sacrament of Confirmation on Saturday, April 28th at the 5:00 p.m. Mass. Msgr. Fran Cilia, Vicar General, celebrated Mass and ministered the Sacrament of Confirmation. I am especially grateful to the parents, sponsors and our parish Confirmation Team, coordinated by Joan Schenck, our Director of Religious Education. Our youth have demonstrated a willingness to commit to their Catholic faith by word and witness. I invite and encourage you to keep our youth in your prayers as they join us in our journey of faith.

Do you know that we are saving money for replacement of the church roof? Our church roof can only last for 50 years, according to the structural engineers, and it has already been 49 years since the church was built in 1963. RESPONDING TO THE CALL

Do we truly know the voice of Christ? Do we truly respond to the voice of our shepherd with our own distinctive voice? How often we attempt to imitate those around us, appropriating the response of another member of the flock to Christ. Perhaps we need to balance the image of being sheep of one flock with the image from the second reading, which tells us that we are all children of God. What child has precisely the same interaction with parents as his or her siblings? Instead, they frequently do and say things to distinguish themselves in the eyes of their parents.

Whether we use the image of children or of sheep to understand our relationship with Christ, we believe that we are all known and called by name. With this great gift comes a responsibility: to respond to the call with our own distinctive voice, to take time to discern exactly what our call is, to determine precisely what the will of the Father is for each of us.

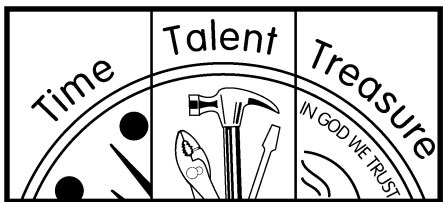

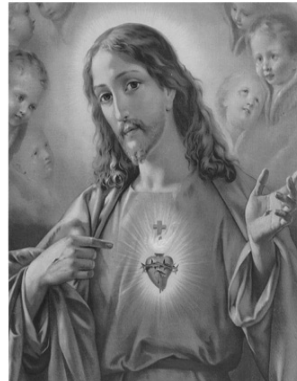

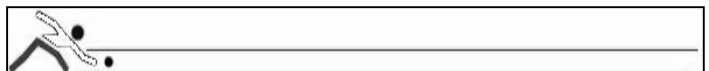
