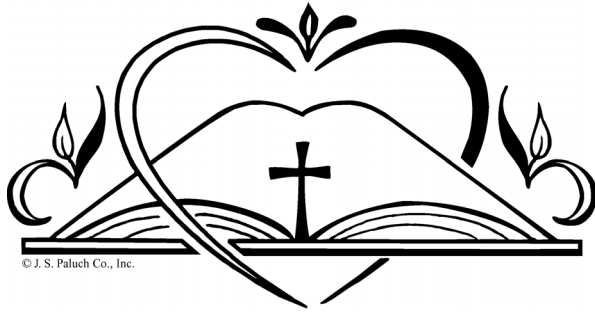

#### **DISCUSSION GROUP ON THE NICENE CREED:**

Over the last year, I have had a little one person discussion group on the Nicene Creed with one of your fellow parishioners. After thinking about it with him and speaking with your pastor, I would like to see if I can broaden the discussion. I am proposing a discussion group [this would definitely NOT be a class!] of perhaps 8 to 12 people who would meet in the Parish Center every two weeks on a Saturday evening from 7p to 8p. We would go through each chapter on a kind of question and answer basis. I would expect, hope?, that those who participate have read each chapter beforehand, and, maybe even take notes!

The point is to learn about the prayer that we pray every week on Sunday after the homily and before the great prayer of the Eucharist, to try to get some understanding of what it means and how its meaning pervades Christian faith, and what the various meanings of faith are.

I would use the Third Edition [Revised and Expanded] of THE CREED, The Apostolic Faith in Contemporary Theology, by Berard L. Marthaler, taking 1 chapter at each meeting. The book is easily available on Amazon.com or DealOz, with the price ranging from about \$6.00 used to \$20.00-\$25.00 new in paperback.

Our discussion group would begin on Saturday, October 11th and continue every other week in the Parish Center Living Room from 7pm to 8pm. Please contact me at 408 -554-4124 or pgoda@scu.edu if you are interested.
