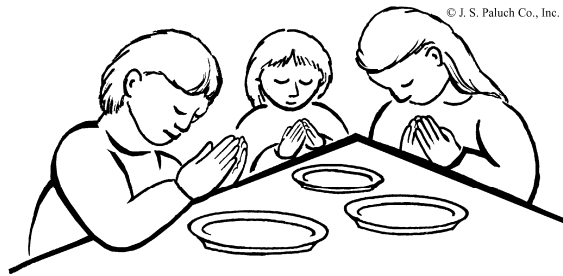

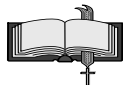

Pastor's Corner THE CREED 2

Jesus is fully divine. On Sunday, November 27th, we join with all Catholics in the United States of America to begin the Creed with the words “**I believe**” instead of “**We believe.**” Another noticeable change comes in the line about Jesus’ divinity. We currently say that Jesus is “**one in Being with the Father.**” The new text says that Jesus is “**consubstantial with the Father.**” The word “**consubstantial**” is not a translation, but rather a transliteration (the same Latin word, spelled in English) of the Latin “**consubstantialis**”, which means “one in being.” The point remains the same: Jesus is God, one with the Father.

Jesus is fully human. Another change appears when we speak of Jesus’ human nature. We currently say “**by the power of the Holy Spirit he was born of the Virgin Mary and became man.**” The new text will say that Jesus “**by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man.**” The word “**incarnate**” means “enfleshed,” so using the term here reminds us that Jesus was human from the moment of his conception, not just at his birth.

There are several other minor changes in the new text of the Creed. It will probably take us a while to commit the new version to memory so that we can profess it together easily. Please see the full new text of the Creed on the next page of the bulletin.

I have shared with you the first part of the Mass: Introductory Rite, Penitential Rite, Liturgy of the Word, the Creed, and the petitions. I will share with you the Liturgy of the Eucharist in the next bulletins.

THE CREED

On November 27th, 2011, the First Sunday of Advent, the beginning of the Church calendar, Catholics in the United States will begin using the new translation of the Creed, the Profession of Faith (the Nicene Creed) at Mass. The following is the full text of the new translation with the changes in bold print;

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty,
maker of heaven and earth,
of **all things visible and invisible.**

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ,
the Only **Begotten** Son of God,
born of the Father **before all ages.**

God from God, Light from Light,
true God from true God,
begotten, not made,
consubstantial with the Father,
through Him all things were made.

For us men and for our salvation
He came down from heaven,
and by the Holy Spirit

was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.
For our sake He was crucified under Pontius Pilate,
He suffered death and was buried,
and rose again on the third day in accordance with
the Scriptures.

He ascended into heaven and
is seated at the right hand of the Father.
He will come again in glory to judge the living and the
dead and His Kingdom will have no end.


I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord,
the giver of life,
who proceeds from the Father and the Son,
who with the Father and the Son **is adored** and glorified,
who has spoken through the prophets.
I believe One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church.
I confess one baptism for the forgiveness of sins
and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead
and the life of the world to come. Amen.
