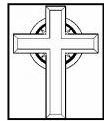

Infant Baptism

Parents must be registered in the parish a minimum of 3 months prior to taking the baptismal preparation class. Contact the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Please contact the Parish Office if you are baptized in the Catholic Church and seeking confirmation as an adult, or are considering or desiring to become Catholic and are baptized in another Christian church or are not baptized and are 7 years of age or older.

Marriage

COME TO THE FEAST

"On this mountain, the Lord of hosts / will provide for all peoples / a feast of rich food and choice wines" (Isaiah 25:6). That's what Isaiah tells us today. God is putting together a huge party for "all peoples," to "wipe away / the tears from every face" (Isaiah 25:8). And what does Jesus tell us? The reign of God, he says, "may be likened to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son" (Matthew 22:2). When the guests didn't come, the king had his servants go out "into the main roads and invite to the feast whomever you find" (Matthew 22:9). We are called to deliver that invitation. One of the themes woven into today's liturgy is that of divine generosity. Asleep to reality, people often think they have "earned" what they have. In our better moments, though, we know that all our gifts—even the spiritual gifts—come through God's generosity. Our vocation is to invite people, to remind them the tickets aren't for sale. 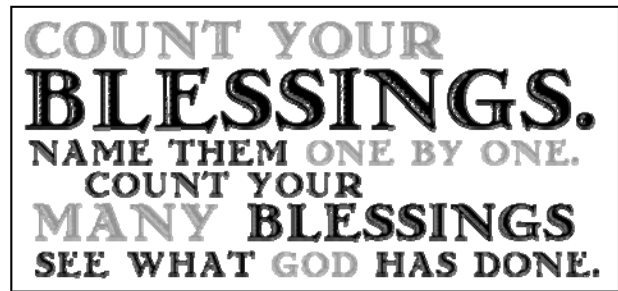

Religious Education & LIFE TEEN

It is NOT too late to sign up for Religious Education classes K-12, and Sacraments of Reconciliation & Holy Communion which will be in March (Recon) and (Communion) May 16, 2015 at 11:00am Mass. Children must go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation before receiving Holy Communion for the first time, CCC #1457. Eucharist is the "source and summit of the Christian life CCC #1324. We still have lots of room in Religious Education third grade for the children who received First Communion last May 2014.

RCIC, the Rite of Christian Initiation for Children CCC#1212, if your child is over the age of 7 and not Baptized. These three Sacraments will be celebrated at the Easter Vigil Mass on Saturday, April 4, 2015 at 8pm. Classes are held on Wednesdays at 5:00pm to 6:15pm.

For the Sacrament of Confirmation in grades 8-12 we are still accepting applications from the school students and the Parish Religious Education Confirmation Class. This Sacrament will be celebrated on Saturday, April 18, 2015 at 5pm Mass. Candidates for Confirmation, as for Baptism, seeks the spiritual help of a Sponsor. To emphasize the unity of Baptism and Confirmation, it is appropriate that the Sponsor be ONE of the Baptismal Godparents CCC# 1311. Do not hesitate to register for any of these classes and/or Sacraments, so there will be enough textbooks for everyone.
