### Infant Baptism

Parents must be registered in the parish a minimum of 3 months prior to taking the baptismal preparation class. Contact the Parish Office.

### Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Please contact the Parish Office if you are baptized in the Catholic Church and seeking confirmation as an adult, or are considering or desiring to become Catholic and are baptized in another Christian church or are not baptized and are 7 years of age or older.

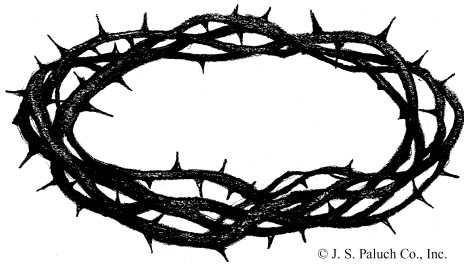

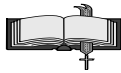

### SERVITUDE

Jesus Christ did not come to be served but to serve and give his life as ransom for many (Mk. 10:35-45), this weekend's Gospel. Jesus tries to show us that real power, divine power, expresses itself in loving service, in giving oneself for others. If we really share in the life of Christ, we too shall become servants of others--offering our services, not demanding rank and approval.

Let us remember that judgment must only come from God alone. We please God when we show humility, but not when we arrogantly exalt ourselves or pass judgment upon others. May we find favor in His sight by living according to the Gospel of His Son, Jesus Christ.

The month of November is coming up soon. The Catholic Church delegates the month-long commemoration of prayer for the deceased during the month of November. Traditionally the Church has always firmly believed that we are forever united with those who have gone before us in death. St. Frances Cabrini Parish will begin this month-long of prayer for the dead with a special celebration (no Mass) on **Friday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, at 7:00 p.m.**, the Annual Feast of All Souls. We commend those who have gone before us to the Lord's eternal care. If you want your loved ones to be mentioned at the celebration, please give us their names by calling the parish office. You can also bring the pictures of your beloved dead and place them on the altar of the dead in the church. As we pray for the dead, together we pray:

through the mercy of God, rest in peace.  
Amen.**

**THE HUMANITY OF JESUS CHRIST**

All three readings today support—each in its own way, of course—a reflection on the humanity of Jesus Christ and how that humanity played a key role in the drama of our salvation. Although not chosen specifically to coordinate with the other two readings, today's second reading does in fact carry forward the theme of Christ's humanity in a remarkable way. The author of the Letter to the Hebrews highlights the solidarity that exists between Jesus and us, precisely because in his human nature Jesus has known the same sufferings and testing that are our own experience. Because he can "sympathize with our weaknesses," we can "approach the throne of grace to receive mercy." For the author of Hebrews, the humanity of Jesus was an essential requirement for his redemptive death, as well as an invitation to us to find in Jesus someone with whom we can identify in our daily struggles.
