Infant Baptism

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

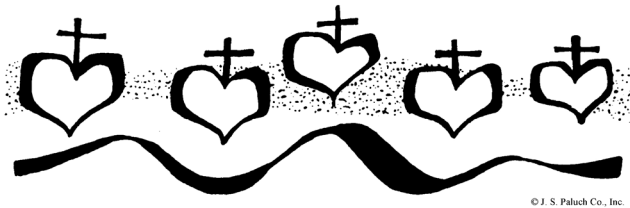
