Infant Baptism

Parents must be registered in the parish a minimum of 3 months prior to taking the baptismal preparation class. Contact the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Please contact the Parish Office if you are baptized in the Catholic Church and seeking confirmation as an adult, or are considering or desiring to become Catholic and are baptized in another Christian church or are not baptized and are 7 years of age or older.

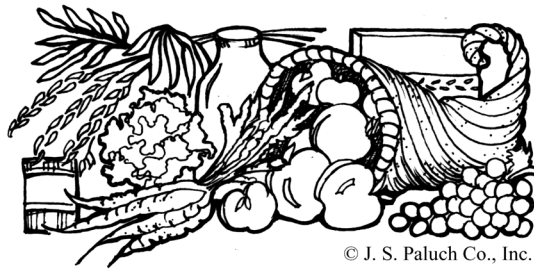

Thanksgiving Food Donation Program

We have just completed our Thanksgiving Food Donation Program held on Saturday November 22nd. We would like to thank all of you who generously donated your time, or who supported this effort with food or monetary donations. We now focus on the Christmas Holiday, and providing both food and toys to those less fortunate in our community. We annually serve 250 families at this event, the number grows each year. As we have the past two years we not only support those in the Cambrian Park and SFC Community, but we support 90 families from Christ the King Parish located in South East San Jose. During Thanksgiving we provided 90 turkeys to Christ the King. During Christmas, we do not supply toys or turkeys, but we do supply food staples for 90 families. The Christmas event will be held Saturday December 20, we begin setting up for the food and toy distribution at 8 am, and begin distributing items around 9:30 to 10 AM. We will accept donations the day of the event, you can drop off food or toys to volunteers beginning at 8 AM.

We are seeking toys for those ages 3-13, boys and girls. Unwrapped toys can be placed in the donation boxes in the vestibule of the Church, or under the Christmas Giving Tree which will be set up and in place in the church next week.
