Infant Baptism

Parents must be registered in the parish a minimum of 3 months prior to taking the baptismal preparation class. Contact the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Please contact the Parish Office if you are baptized in the Catholic Church and seeking confirmation as an adult, or are considering or desiring to become Catholic and are baptized in another Christian church or are not baptized and are 7 years of age or older.

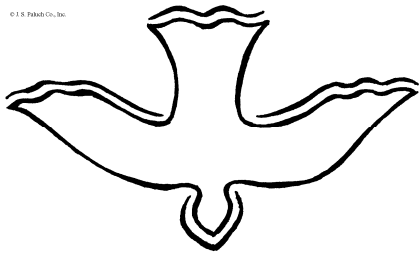

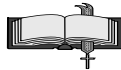

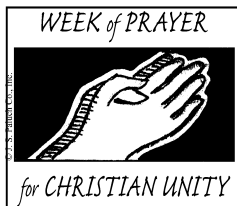

This is the fifth year this **Four Chaplains Interfaith Memorial Service** will be held at St. Frances Cabrini in remembrance of these four chaplains who were aboard the *USAT Dorchester*, which was carrying over 900 personnel when, on February 3, 1943, it was hit by a torpedo. During the chaos the chaplains assisted the frightened and bewildered to abandon the ship into the dark North Atlantic. They eventually gave away their life preservers so that four others would have a second chance at life.

Reflections by Bob Dodds—In Thanksgiving

An Epiphany is a new way of seeing things, letting in new light, embracing new love. . .

In this day of instant communication with, for example, IPODS, IPADS, IPHONES, during a personal crisis recently, I saw many things through a new set of eyes. For all the hundreds of prayers and Masses I am truly grateful. Some have thought that the community and I were separated, but I never felt that way for a moment.

For the things in life that really matter, the community reached out to me. I saw so many things in a different light during the past 25 days. I even learned the importance of an endless supply of medical gloves that it takes to maintain an ICU. It took me 21 days to realize that a hairless chest is far less painful!!!

This past week has ended the Christmas Season. Fr. Paul reminded us of his Christmas homily, which asked the question: "What did we come to the manger to see? . . . We came to see a child, not wrapped in riches, but in swaddling clothes. . ." The question I ponder now is: "What does the manger do to hold us?"

The light that shone in darkness helps us to see with new eyes; to see things that we missed before; to see new possibilities, new hope and new insights; perhaps to appreciate relationships in new ways. Even circumstances we thought were hopeless now offer new opportunities for hope.

Where is the darkness that needs light? Are we looking with new eyes? Are we saying "yes" to a new year, to a new way of seeing things???

May our community continue to grow and thrive.
