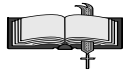

THE CHURCH

We are going to begin the 2012 Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA) campaign soon with the theme: **OUR PARISH, OUR DIOCESE, TOGETHER IN CHRIST.** This campaign will begin on the weekend of February 5th and will end on the weekend of April 1st -- nine weeks long. I will report to you about how we are progressing each week.

What is the ADA? ADA is an annual fund-raising for the Diocese of San Jose. Each year, the fifty three parishes and missions of our local Church of San Jose take part in the ADA to provide support primarily for the shared ministries and services across all of the parishes and missions, such as, the Institute for Leadership in Ministry, Youth and Young Adult Groups, Family Life, Catechetical Ministry, Faith and Justice Ministry, the Valley Catholic, Detention Ministry, Personnel, Seminarians, Vocation, Retired Priests, Stewardship training for parishes, personnel services and support for the schools and parishes.

This year our 2012 ADA goal is \$144,000. Last year during tough economic times I was very proud that the members of St. Frances Cabrini Parish were able to rally together and meet our ADA goal. I pray that this year members of St. Frances Cabrini Parish once again pull together and help us to meet this year’s ADA goal so that we can help others, because we all are together in Christ, His Church.

We will join with the ADA campaign to raise money to replace our church roof. Every dollar and cent over the ADA goal will be added to the saving fund, which will be used to replace the roof. Let us come together to achieve the ADA goal and replace our church roof.

The American Legion invites the parishioners of Saint Frances Cabrini to join with veterans of Santa Clara County on Saturday, February 11, 2012, at 11:00 AM, to pay tribute to four chaplains who made the ultimate sacrifice of life for their God, Country, and fellow man.

This is the fifth year this **Four Chaplains Interfaith Memorial Service** will be held at St. Frances Cabrini in remembrance of these four chaplains who were aboard the *USAT Dorchester*, which was carrying over 900 personnel when, on February 3, 1943, it was hit by a torpedo. During the chaos the chaplains assisted the frightened and bewildered to abandon the ship into the dark North Atlantic. They eventually gave away their life preservers so that four others would have a second chance at life. Please join us to share an hour of time in tribute to the unselfish sacrifice of these and many more who sacrificed eternity. Freedom is not free.
