

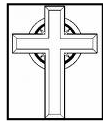

Infant Baptism

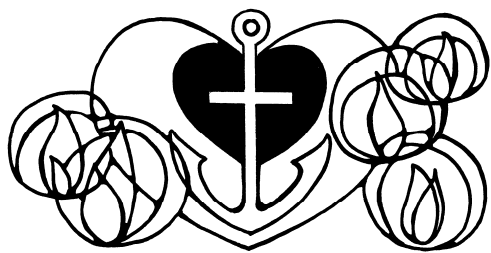

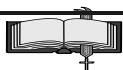

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The song of the angels, “Holy, Holy, Holy,” resounds from our lips at every Mass. There was a widespread belief in the first religions of the world that God stirred creation into being by a word, a song, a musical note. Music and a sense of God’s presence have always been inseparable. In the liturgy, your voice is invited into this song as the priest names the reasons for our praise. “Heaven and earth are full of your glory,” and we are not passive onlookers, but participants in this glory. Catholic prayer no longer assigns this angelic hymn to a choir, but gives it to you to sing. Even if your voice is thought to be suitable only for a well-insulated shower stall, you are called into this song.

We are born to sing—just listen to a baby testing the full range of newly discovered vocal abilities. Soon we get shushed and hushed into quiet, and given lots of messages that our voices are unwanted, and that we need to raise our hands in order to be heard. All of that is overturned in liturgy, the place where God waits to hear us come alive in the song of all creation. In heaven, everyone’s in the choir; why not start practicing now?

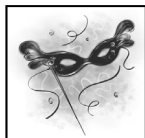

Four Chaplains Interfaith Memorial Service

Parishioners and friends are invited to attend the sixth annual **Four Chaplains Interfaith Memorial Service** at St. Francis Cabrini Church on **Saturday, February 9, 2013, at 10:00am** in memory of four military chaplains who served their God, their Country, and their fellow man. These four men gave their life so others may live; join in this commemoration of their sacrifice. They gave their life to eternity for their fellow man, could we not give but one hour for them.

These four, of the Jewish, Catholic, and Protestant faiths were aboard a troop transport ship carrying over 900 personnel, which was torpedoed in the North Atlantic. They assisted the frightened and bewildered, and eventually gave away their own life preservers so that others would have a second chance at life.

Please join in giving tribute to these four chaplains who saved so many, and then in communion made the ultimate sacrifice. Let us not forget those that served, or are now serving their God, their Country, and their fellow man for our benefit.
