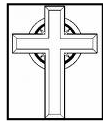

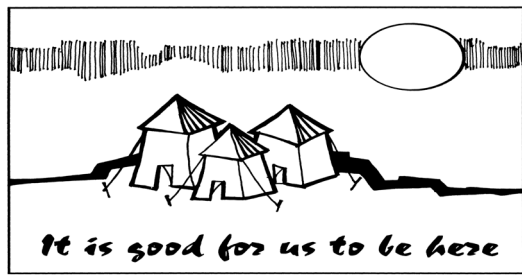

CELEBRATION OF THE FEAST OF SAN PEDRO CALUNGSOD

St. Peter Calungsod as he is also known was a young Filipino migrant, sacristan and missionary catechist who along with Spanish Jesuit missionary, Luis de San Vitores preached Christianity to Chamorro people in Guam in 1672. Both suffered religious persecution and martyrdom for their missionary work and died. Pedro Calungsod was beatified on March 5, 2000 at St. Peter's Basilica by Pope John Paul II and canonized on Oct. 21, 2012 by Pope Benedict XVI.

It is also a time to give food or almsgiving to those less fortunate with more love in your heart. What will you and your family do this Lent to become more like Jesus Christ? The old saying "the Bible that is falling apart belongs to someone who is not falling apart", is true.
