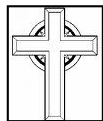

Infant Baptism

Parents must be registered in the parish a minimum of 3 months prior to taking the baptismal preparation class. Contact the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Please contact the Parish Office if you are baptized in the Catholic Church and seeking confirmation as an adult, or are considering or desiring to become Catholic and are baptized in another Christian church or are not baptized and are 7 years of age or older.

PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Success! In less than 2 months, the Saint Frances Cabrini community came together and raised over \$250,000! We have met our goal for the combined Annual Diocesan Appeal (ADA) and Pavement Improvement Project (PIP). We were even able to complete the fundraising ahead of schedule, well in advance of Easter!

Thank you to all members of the Saint Frances Cabrini community who pledged support to this project. Over 500 households participated in this effort – an unprecedented number! The generous responses are impressive and demonstrate the commitment we have to our Cabrini community.

The pavement improvements are scheduled to take place this summer. As we get closer to starting the project, there will be more information in the bulletin about the project details.

Meeting this goal enables the project to move forward without significantly impacting parish or school savings. The full cost of the pavement improvements is estimated at \$240,000 and our successful fundraising has contributed over 50% of this cost. Additional gifts are welcome and will help to reduce the amount that the parish and school contribute from savings.

Pledge cards can continue to be returned in the offertory collection at Mass, dropped off at the parish or school office, or placed in the mail. Thank you to the entire Cabrini community for the support, generosity and prayers for this project!

Thank You from the SFC Altar Society. The Altar Society would like to thank the 10 adults and 3 children who spent Saturday, April 5th, cleaning our church pews. It was hard work and the Time and Talent with the boundless energy that was so graciously given to is appreciated. The pews look very nice as does the rest of our beautiful church.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY AT ST. FRANCES CABRINI

We will be celebrating the Feast of Divine Mercy on Sunday, April 27th beginning with Confessions at 1:30 pm followed by the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at 3:00 pm and concluding with the celebration of Holy Mass at 3:15 pm. Holy Mass will be celebrated by Fr. Michael Hendrickson. The Novena leading up to Divine Mercy Sunday will begin on Good Friday.

WHAT IS DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY?

Divine Mercy Sunday is the title of the Second Sunday of the Easter season. It was named by Pope John Paul II at the canonization of St. Maria Faustina on April 30, 2000, and then officially decreed by the Vatican.

Pope John Paul II described Mercy Sunday: "In a special way, it is the *Sunday of thanksgiving* for all goodness that God has shown us in the whole Easter mystery". Here, He is underscoring the Church's understanding that Divine Mercy Sunday, as the Octave Day of Easter, brings us the fullness of Christ's Resurrection—pointing back to the first day of our celebration on Easter Sunday, and now to its fullness on the eighth day, the Octave.

Our Lord revealed various revelations about His mercy to St. Faustina, including the flood of mercy which is available on this day "for all should, especially for poor sinners". The following is one of those revelations:

The soul that will go to Confession (beforehand) and receive Holy Communion (on that day) shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (Purgatory). (In addition, you must Pray for the intentions of the Pope and with a soul totally detached from affection to any sin, even venial, participate in one of the pious practices undertaken in honor of Divine Mercy

(one-half hour in Adoration, pray a public rosary or pray the 14 Stations of the Cross.)
