

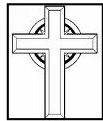

SACRAMENTAL LIFE

Infant Baptism

Parents must be registered in the parish a minimum of 3 months prior to taking the baptismal preparation class. Contact the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Please contact the Parish Office if you are baptized in the Catholic Church and seeking confirmation as an adult, or are considering or desiring to become Catholic and are baptized in another Christian church or are not baptized and are 7 years of age or older.

Marriage

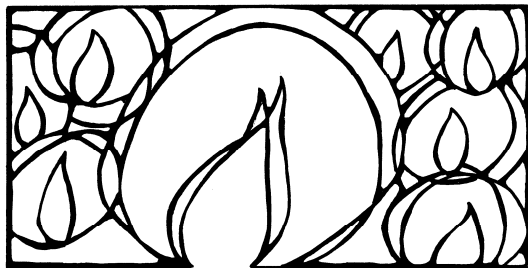

THE DAY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

John's Gospel tells us that when Jesus "breathed" on the disciples, the Holy Spirit came into them, empowering them to forgive sins and to gather all people into union with one another.

The book of Genesis had explained the divisions among nations with the story of the Tower of Babel. In rebellious pride, human beings had struggled to become equal to God. The result was chaos, strife, the inability even to speak the same language among themselves. Today's reading from Acts tells how the Spirit has just the opposite effect. Strangers from many nations hear and understand one another, each in his or her own tongue.

This message of unity in the Spirit is repeated in the reading from Corinthians. There are many gifts, many ways to serve. One way is not "higher," nor one person "better" than another. There is but one Spirit, who accomplishes all the different works we do, acting through us.

Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth" (Psalm 104). This Monday, May 20th, the day after Pentecost Sunday, the Most Reverend Bishop Thomas Daly will be here for the liturgical celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation. Sixty five young men and women, ages 14 to 17, will be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit to become fully initiated into the Catholic Faith. They have all written a letter to Bishop Daly requesting the Sacrament stating how they prepared themselves, and how they can make a difference in the world. During this "Year of Faith" they prayed all year long to continue growing in faith as a disciple of Christ. They have attended a youth rally, participated in a teen retreat, and have completed hundreds of service hours preaching the Gospel and when necessary using words as St. Francis of Assisi taught us by example. Many have reflected on the fruits of the Holy Spirit which is "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control", and how they can live in the Spirit and follow the Spirit. (Galatians, 5:22-23,25). Thank you to everyone who has helped these teens along their journey, especially their parents, the first teachers of the faith. God bless the Confirmandi, their sponsors, Godparents, priests, teachers, and catechists. Please keep them in your prayers.

Thursday night Bocce Ball is now open for all to enjoy!

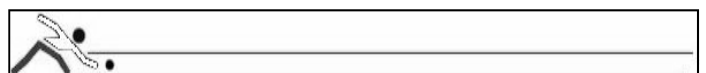
