Infant Baptism

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Please contact the Parish Office if you are baptized in the Catholic Church and seeking confirmation as an adult, or are considering or desiring to become Catholic and are baptized in another Christian church or are not baptized and are 7 years of age or older.

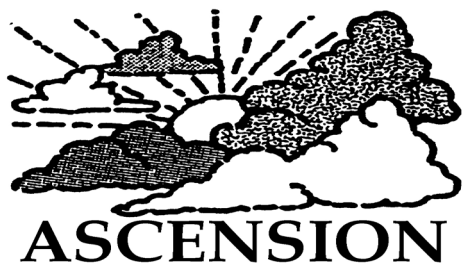

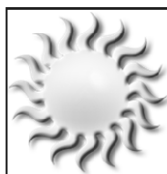

What happens in the Church when she cele- brates the Eucharist?

Every time the Church celebrates the Eucharist, she stands
before the source from which she herself constantly springs
anew. By "eating" the Body of Christ, the Church becomes
the Body of Christ, which is just another name for the
Church. In the sacrifice of Christ, who gives himself to us,
body and soul, there is room for our whole life. We can
unite everything: our work and our sufferings, our joys with
Christ's sacrifice. If we offer ourselves in this way, we are
transformed: We become pleasing to God and like good,
nourishing bread for our fellowmen. Again and again we
grumble about the Church, as though she were just an as-
sociation of more or less good people. In reality the Church
is what happens daily in a mysterious way at the altar. God
gives himself to each one of us individually, and he wants to
transform us through communion with him. Once we are
transformed, we are supposed to transform the world. Ever-
thing else that the Church is besides that is secondary.

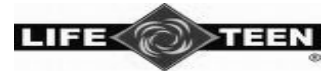

Religious Education is now over for the summer. The 61 student's names for the Sacrament of Confirmation and the 91 student's names for Sacrament of Eucharist are currently being recorded into the SFC Church records, the first and most important step. The few RCIA/RCIA names for Baptism and Sacraments received at the Easter Vigil Mass are now done and certificates have been distributed. The certificates for Confirmation and First Communion will be ready in about two weeks. The school children will bring them home after school. The Religious Education & Home schooling parents will be called to either come to pick up the certificate in the parish center or I can meet anyone at the 9:30am Mass on Sundays. A sincere thank you to all the teachers and aides who prepared the students for these Sacraments. I will see you all in the fall when you register for the next grade, especially the 25 Religious Ed First Communicants as they move on to third grade.

Thank you sincerely to my Religious Education staff of dedicated volunteers who help co-teach the faith with you to your children. Year after year they eagerly come back and look forward to working with their new students. They do so because they are intentional disciples of Jesus Christ. Please pray for all these Wednesday evening teachers and aides who volunteer at 5:00pm and 6:15pm every week, and the Sunday morning teachers and aides who lead the "Children's Liturgy of the Word" program at the 9:30am Family Mass.
