THE COSTS OF DISCIPLESHIP

Today's responsorial psalm, Psalm 40, is more familiar to us with the refrain "Here am I, Lord." This "Here am I" is Jeremiah's great prophetic response to God's call. But today's story of Jeremiah and the refrain "Lord, come to my aid!" remind us that there are always two sides to following the call of God. The author of the Letter to the Hebrews knew this, too. He reminded his readers that even weighted down with burdens and sins, we can still persevere by keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus, who himself knew the shame and pain of the cross, but saw beyond it to the joy of sitting at the right of the throne of God. Jesus himself gave the disciples a "sneak preview" of a baptism that would not be as wondrous as the one in the Jordan that inaugurated his ministry, but would be one of fire and anguish. Today's words from scripture may not be terribly soothing, but in their honesty and strength we can acknowledge the difficulties of daily discipleship, and take comfort in the assurance of our own salvation in Christ.

Catholic Professionals board members have been busy over the summer planning Season 13. We are happy to announce that we have selected a new place to hold our speaker events. Also, we have reduced the meal fees for both our members and for our newcomers and guests.

Please read on.

The Board of Directors has been investigating a different venue for our breakfast meetings, with a lower cost basis, so we could in turn lower the breakfast cost to you. We felt this would have a positive impact on membership and the club overall. Notification of the impending closure in 2014 for renovation of our current venue, the San Jose Airport Garden Hotel, was another factor in our decision to find a new venue. The new location will be at the **Three Flames Restaurant**, located at 1547 Meridian Avenue (just north of Hamilton Ave) in San Jose. We found a high percentage of our membership live and/or work in this area. Great access to both 880/17 and 280 and the drive to downtown is less than 4 miles. Parking is plentiful (no more full spaces due to hotel conferences). and 3 private separate entrances are available for our group to use.

Our new breakfast fees are as follows:

\$15 for members; \$20 for non- members

We were able to provide these lower prices because of the reasonable hot buffet breakfast being offered to our group, along with no room rental fees and no A/V fees.

Mass time will be **7:00am** (15 minutes later). However, please note - we do not plan to change the finish time. The meeting will still adjourn no later than 9:00am.

We are very optimistic about this new facility and welcome your candid feedback after your attendance at our September 12th kickoff meeting.

Registration for Religious Education classes will begin the Wednesday after Labor Day, September 4th. Classes for Grades K-6 are held on Wednesdays from 5:00pm to 6:15pm in the school classrooms. Grades 7-12 meet on Wednesdays from 6:15pm to 7:30pm in the parish center using the youth ministry model. All classes will begin on Wednesday, October 2nd. Thank you, and I look forward to the new school year partnering with you for the faith formation of your children.
