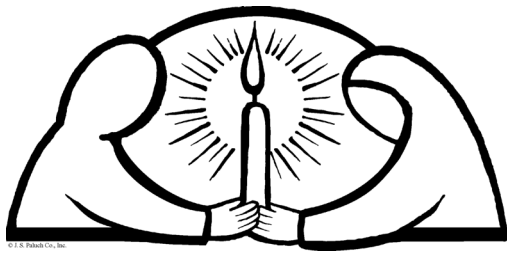

In the final verses of today’s Gospel reading Jesus says that when two or three are gathered in his name, “there am I in the midst of them” (Matthew 18:20). 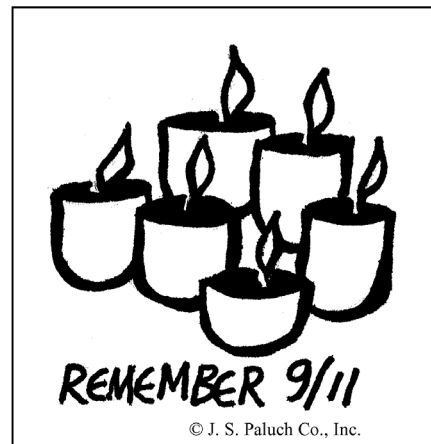

What is the Theology of the Body and how can it change my life? by Christopher West

A preview of the upcoming Class called "Into the Heart" by Christopher West,

starting September 29th thru November 17th, 2014 at St. Frances Cabrini church.

This will be a 16 week Video/Workbook class.

We can't live without it. The deepest part of our being yearns for intimacy and companionship. For 2,000 years, the Catholic Church has taught not only about love but also about sexual love. If you compiled all the Churches doctrinal statements on sexual love, you would end up with a 6,000-page book. Amazingly, two thirds of these pages would be from the writings of one person: *Pope John Paul II*. He evidently had a lot to say on the subject. But in the world where millions of webpages of sexual information are just a mouse click away, why should anyone care what a deceased, celibate man had to say on the subject?

Here's the answer: because *John Paul II's* inspired vision presents the heavenly food that truly satisfies our hunger for love. Men and women today are often so starved for love that they turn to some very unhealthy food to satisfy their hunger. John Paul II's rich teaching, known as the ***Theology of the Body***, presents the banquet that truly satisfies, and the whole world is invited to the feast.

Why is the theology of the body destined to have such a profound impact on the world? The reason is that civilization stands or falls on the relationship of man and woman. The sexual embrace is the foundation stone of human life. The family—and, in turn, human society itself—springs from this embrace. In short, as sex goes, so go marriage and the family. As marriage and the family go, so goes civilization. *John Paul II* began his pontificate with a catechesis on the ***Theology of the Body*** because he knew we cannot address social problems and build a culture of life if we do not understand and embrace God's plan for human sexuality. Please join us as we explore John Paul II's explanation of this church doctrine September 29th at 7pm in the church.
