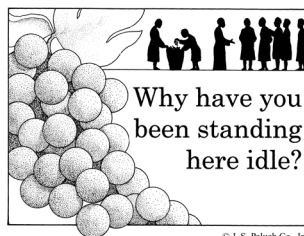

Assyrian Christian's survival is at stake Today over 120,000 Assyrian are being sheltered in churches, halls, vacant homes, anywhere they can find place to sleep, even on sidewalks and in parks. It is unfortunate to see, that in the 21st century, Assyrians are facing another genocide because they believe in Christ. Over 100 Catholics churches and old monasteries have been destroyed. DISCUSSION GROUP ON THE NICENE CREED:

Over the last year, (note the length!) I have had a little one person discussion group on the Nicene Creed with one of your fellow parishioners. After thinking about it with him and speaking with your pastor, I would like to see if I can broaden the discussion. I am proposing a discussion group (this would definitely NOT be a class!) of 8 people who would meet in the Parish Center roughly every two weeks on a weekday evening from 7 pm to 8 pm. We would go through each chapter on a kind of question and answer basis. I would expect, hope?, that those who participate have read each chapter beforehand, and, may-be even have taken notes.

The point is to learn about the prayer that we pray every week on Sunday after the homily and before the great prayer of the Eucharist, to try to get some understanding of what it means and how its meaning pervades Christian faith, and what the various meanings of faith are.

We would use the Third Edition [Revised and Expanded] (2007 with later printings) of THE CREED, The Apostolic Faith in Contemporary Theology by Berard L. Marthaler, taking 1 chapter at each meeting. The book is easily available on Amazon.com or DealOz, with the price ranging from about \$6.00 used to \$20.00 - \$25.00 new in paperback.

Our discussion group would begin on a weekday after the middle of October (we need to determine the best day), and continue every other week, possibly in the Parish Center, from 7 pm to 8 pm.
