Infant Baptism

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Pastor's Corner LOVE

Jesus talks about the great commandment in this weekend's Gospel: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.....You shall love your neighbor as yourself" (Mk. 12:30-31). These two commandments of love are inseparable because love is the spirit behind all of them. As St. Paul tells us in his famous 13th chapter of I Corinthians, "If I have no love, I am nothing."

This week we have the responsibility to exercise our right to vote. I would like to encourage you as parishioners to keep in mind the foundational right that we enjoy, the right to life, from conception to natural death. The Catholic Church has been consistent in this teaching. May each one of us cast our vote to influence public policy and to assure that those elected represent our Catholic values.

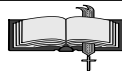

The tradition of the Church has always been firmly in the belief that at the time of death, life is changed but not ended. As it is referenced in the Preface of the Eucharistic Prayer at a funeral Mass, "when the body of our earthly dwelling lies in death, we gain an everlasting dwelling place in heaven." When we pray for those who have died, it is a reminder to us all that our true home is in heaven. We entrust the deceased to the Lord's eternal care as we seek their intercession for us: **May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace...pray for us.**

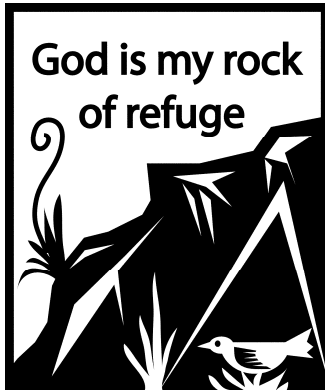

LOVE GOD

As we near the end of the liturgical year we listen to Gospel readings from the final stage of Jesus' ministry—his teaching in Jerusalem. This Sunday Jesus is in conversation with one of the scribes of the temple. In a rare occurrence Jesus and the scribe agree on the two greatest commandments—to love God with all your being and to love your neighbor as yourself.

In today's selection from Deuteronomy Moses gives this teaching to the Israelites as the core of their life of faith and prayer, and Psalm 18 echoes this prayer with the words, "I love you, O LORD, my strength" (Psalm 18:2). Jews and Christians agree that our greatest responsibility is to love the one and only God, and that we cannot claim to love God without loving our neighbor as ourselves.
