

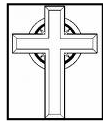

## SACRAMENTAL LIFE

### Infant Baptism

Parents must be registered in the parish a minimum of 3 months prior to taking the baptismal preparation class. Contact the Parish Office.

### Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Please contact the Parish Office if you are baptized in the Catholic Church and seeking confirmation as an adult, or are considering or desiring to become Catholic and are baptized in another Christian church or are not baptized and are 7 years of age or older.

### Marriage

Couples must contact the Priest they wish to witness the Sacrament at least 6 months prior to the proposed date of marriage. Contact the Parish Office.

### Sacraments to the Sick and Homebound

To request Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion at home, hospital, or convalescent facility, contact the Parish Office.

### HOLIDAY FOOD AND GIFT DONATIONS



The SFC Men's Club, Italian Catholic Federation and Mexican Catholic Organization will again be sponsoring the annual Holiday food and gift donation and giveaway.

Dates for these events will be November 23 for Thanksgiving and December 14 for Christmas. We are seeking donations of packaged foods, turkeys and hams for both events, as well as unwrapped gift items for children ages 3 to 13. Donation boxes will be located in the vestibule of the Church beginning November 2.
