Infant Baptism

Parents must be registered in the parish a minimum of 3 months prior to taking the baptismal preparation class. Contact the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

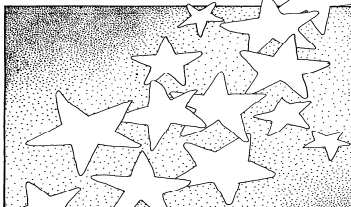

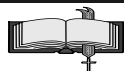

HOPE

This weekend is the last Sunday of Ordinary Time before we are going to celebrate the Feast of Christ the King in the next weekend, the end of the Church Year. As the Church calendar comes to the end, this weekend's readings speak of the momentous events which will herald the end of the world. The prophet Daniel encourages his fellow Jews in the time of the persecution by Antiochus IV (175-163 B.C.) to keep their hope in God. Jesus speaks about the "last things," especially the end of the world and his own Parousia, his second coming to judge all people. Jesus never gives clear dates expressed in years and hours for the end of the world; however, He wants us to be ready for it by our patient endurance and hope which will win us our lives (Lk. 21:5-19).

As we celebrate Thanksgiving Day, I join with my brother priests and the entire staff of our parish and school to thank **ALL** of you for your continued and faithful stewardship and generosity to the parish and school. Please consider starting your thanksgiving prayer by joining us for Mass on Thanksgiving Day morning at 8:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. **Happy Thanksgiving Day to You and Your Family!**
