### Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

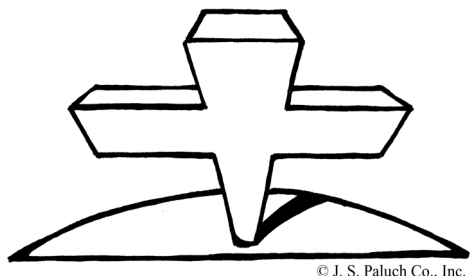

**Special prayers for the Assyrian hostages**

On the fourth Friday of Lent, March 20, 2015, the Assyrian Catholics of Saint Frances Cabrini were honored to have Bishop Patrick McGraw and Monsieur Cilia join Father Michael, Father Paolo, and parishioners as they held a prayer service for the three hundred and seventy-three Assyrian hostages in Syria. Together, the faithful of Saint Frances Cabrini gathered to pray for the men, women, and children affected by the violence in the Middle East as well as the twelve hundred families who were forced to flee from the thirty-three villages being ravaged due to violence. To date, three villages as well as five churches have been completely destroyed, which has shaken the Assyrian community. As a way to show support, three hundred and seventy-three tea light candles were lit and displayed to represent each of the hostages. In a display of solidarity, the church became filled with the flickering lights of the candles.

In these times of distress, the Assyrian community is grateful for the prayers and attention given to those suffering. During this season of Lent, along with the spiritual preparation for the coming of Easter, it is important to include those suffering in our prayers and atonement. The Assyrian Catholics of Saint Frances Cabrini would like to extend a warm thank you for the support of the parishioners and their expressed concern as they took time to come and join in this special prayer service. Additionally, a special thank you to Bishop McGraw and Monsignor Cilia as they took time to preside over this beautiful prayer service.
